E-Invoicing is the direct exchange of invoices between suppliers' and customers' financial systems. Providing similar functionality as EDI solutions, it allows systems to 'speak' to each other, even if only one of the two businesses are using the Sage 300 ERP system - at a significantly lower cost.

The E-Invoice contains all the elements of a normal invoice (invoice date, invoice number, tax number, invoices lines, totals), but it is created and delivered in a format that is designed to be interpreted by software using the PEPPOL standard (<https://peppol.org/>), rather than read by people.

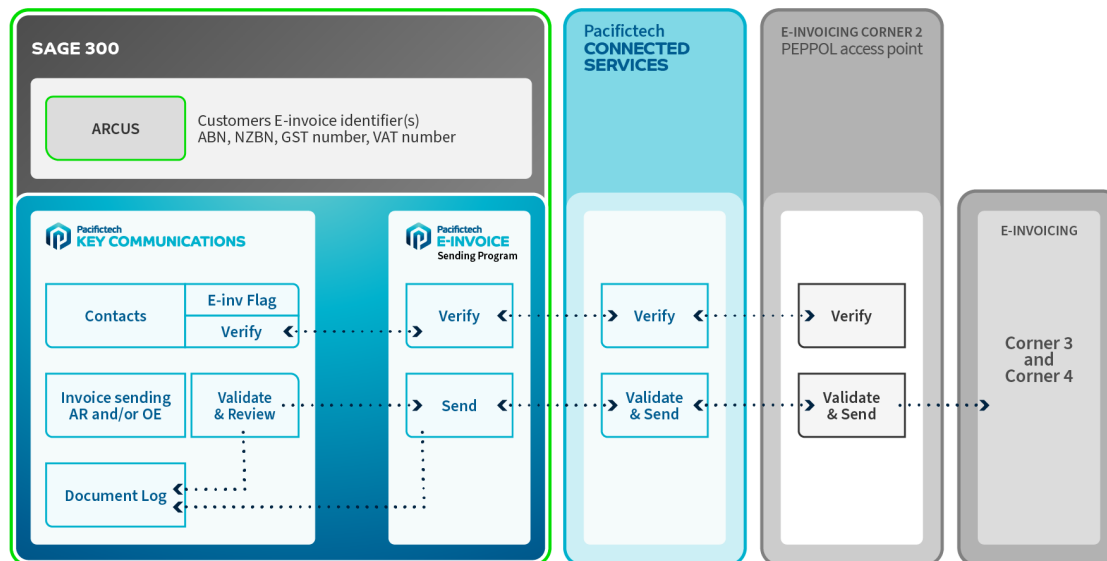
Sending E-Invoices:

Pacifitech E-invoice Sending via the PEPPOL network is for both Order Entry and Accounts Receivable invoices and credit notes. It facilitates streamlining of operations so organisations can leverage multiple invoice channels to deliver invoices to the buyers' ERP systems.

It supports varying and complex compliance requirements such as global e-invoice formats and archiving. Importantly it meets governmental compliance regulations such as post-audits by keeping secure document logs within our Key Communications module. Sending E-invoices makes it easy for you to connect to your customers seamlessly & securely.

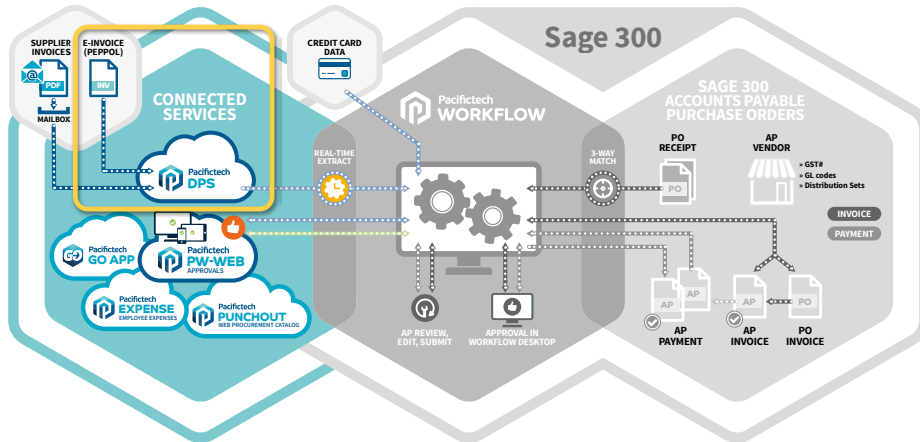

Receiving E-Invoices:

Pacifitech's E-Invoicing is tightly integrated with Sage 300 and automatically ingests the e-invoice data file into our Document Processing Service (DPS) as part of the Pacifitech AP Automation functionality. From there, it gets routed directly into your unique approval workflows.

Pacifitech has engaged an Access Point Partner for the PEPPOL component - which means that there are no additional requirements (or costs). All that is needed in order for Customers to be able to start receiving e-invoices is the DPS Connected Service. For Sage 300 Customers Pacifitech's Payables Workflow and Workflow Documents modules are required.
